The award will be presented to the group which has, in the Judges estimation following a visit to the shortlisted candidates, made the most outstanding contribution to improving the lives of their community. The Award carries with it a framed certificate and a cheque prize of £1,000 from His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales, which the winning group must use to further their community initiatives.

RULES OF THE COMPETITION

1. Open to organisations in Devon only.
2. The information supplied will not be divulged as per GDPR.
3. Preliminary selection will be made using the information supplied by the entrant.
4. The short listed entries will be informed during the first week of May 2021.
5. The short listed entries will be asked to provide a short presentation by Zoom to the judges during the third week of May 2021.
6. The panel of judges will consider the general criteria using the information supplied in conjunction with their visit. Judges will be from The Duchy of Cornwall and the DCAA.
7. The presentation of the Award to the winner of the competition will be made at the Devon County Show on Friday 2nd July 2021.
